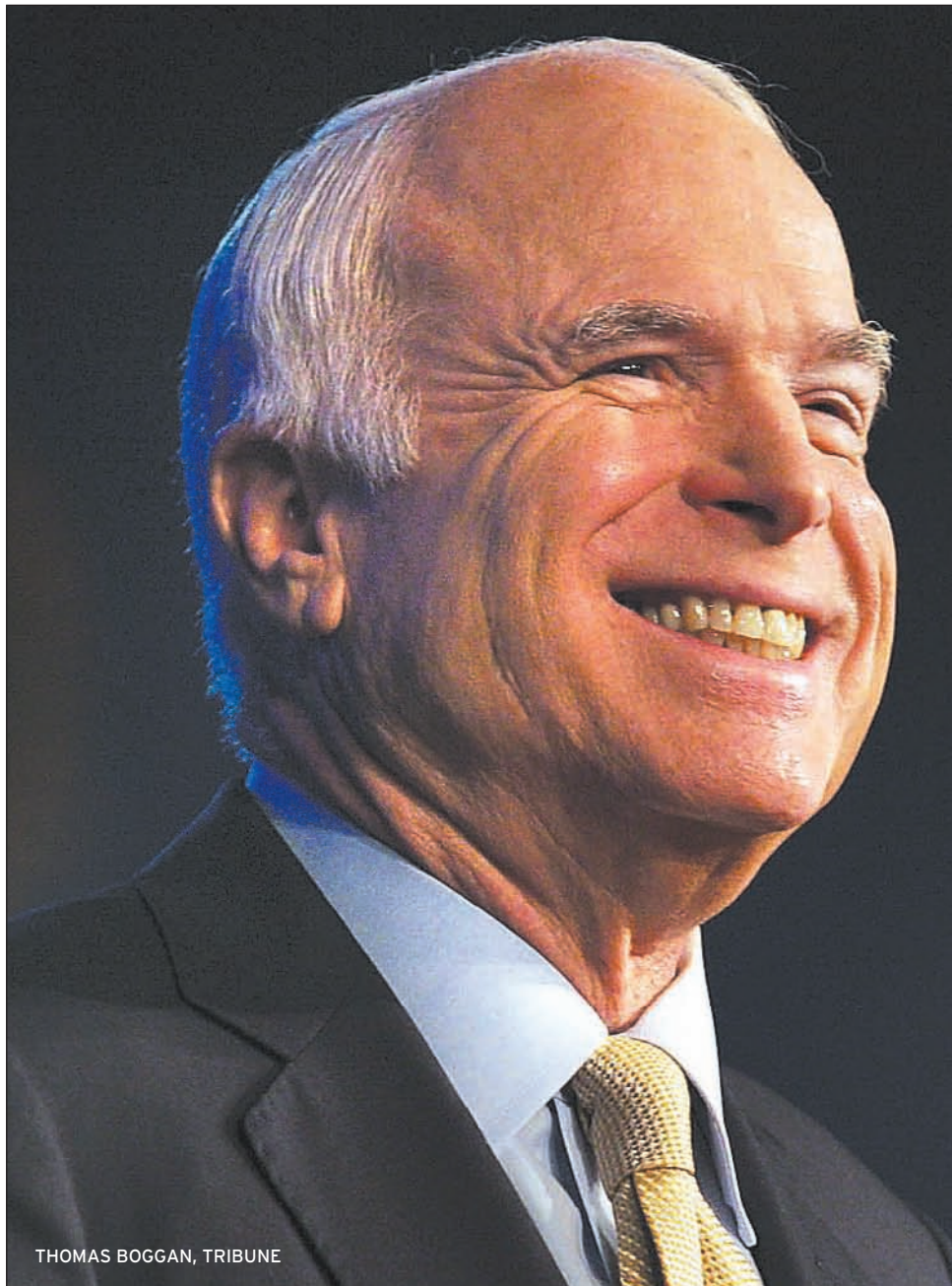

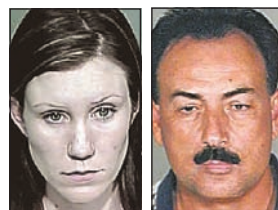


Scottsdale roads are closed due to storm

Man who fired gun in hospital rearrested

A man who wielded a 12-gauge shotgun and fired shots inside a Scottsdale hospital last year and was about to be freed from a mental-health facility was rearrested Tuesday, the Maricopa County Attorney's Office said Tuesday in a **DETAILS, A3** statement.

According to court documents, doctors who had treated Gilbert "Fritz" Tuffi III, 55, of Scottsdale, had said last week they found him not to be a danger to others.

A Maricopa County Superior Court judge had found in July that Tuffi was incompetent to stand trial on three counts of aggravated assault in connection with a July 23, 2007, incident at Scottsdale Healthcare Osborn in which three people received minor injuries.

Tuffi was expected to have been released Tuesday.
