A hiring spree, the introduction of penalties for companies with cost overruns and weeding out bidders found guilty of crimes are among the measures Transport Minister Pierre Moreau says will usher in a new era of transparency and toughness at Transport Quebec. Many of the measures announced yesterday address specific concerns raised by former Montreal police chief Jacques Duchesneau during his investigation of allegations of price-fixing and influence peddling in road contracts. "Quebecers want transparency, toughness and integrity," Moreau said. "They're going to get it."
