

Cap on new office space wins approval

A former basketball coach who worked in Atherton, Redwood City and for the San Mateo County Sheriff's Activities League has been arrested on charges of sexually assaulting a 14-year-old boy, authorities said yesterday.

Caught in a car with a teen boy

Julio Edgardo Ortiz, 34, of Menlo Park, was arrested on Friday by CHP officers who found him in a car with a boy at an I-280 rest stop that overlooks Crystal Springs Reservoir south of Highway 92.

When CHP officers approached his blue Chevrolet Cruze, they saw a man performing a sex act on a teen boy, according to the San Mateo County Sheriff's Office.

Ortiz coached in the Redwood

City Elementary School District at Clifford Elementary School in Redwood City and Selby Lane Elementary in Atherton.

It is believed that Ortiz met the 14-year-old when he coached him at Selby Lane between 2012 and 2014, said San Mateo County Dis- [See COACH, page 22]

YOGI BERRA, a Hall of Fame catcher who in his 17 seasons with the New York Yankees helped the team win 10 World Series championships, has died at age 90. Berra, one of baseball's most beloved figures, had been in failing health for some time.

He cares about poor but denies he is a liberal

The pope of the poor arrived for his first-ever visit to the world's wealthiest superpower Tuesday denying he is a leftist and riding in a frugal little family car, windows rolled down.

Pope Francis' chartered plane from Cuba touched down at Andrews Air Force Base in Maryland, where President Barack Obama and his wife and daughters paid him the rare honor of meeting him at the bottom of the stairs on the red-carpeted tarmac.
