What's new at Ivy Tech?

Just walk inside the newly remodeled Ivy Tech Community College Hamilton County Campus in Noblesville, and you'll see what people mean when they say they don't recognize the former Noblesville High School.

The entrance that was constructed on a school budget is now a grand atrium, that's light and bright with windows, high ceilings and lots of space where students can hang out. The school's gymnasium floor has been refinished, with large green Ivy Tech logos added. And there's a new entrance off of a new parking lot with new signage.

On Tuesday, the community is invited to tour the newly remodeled campus during a special grand opening, from 3 to 5 p.m. Ivy Tech Community College president Thomas Snyder, Ivy Tech Central Indiana Region Chancellor Kathleen Lee, Noblesville Mayor John Ditslear and Sen. Luke Kenley (R-Noblesville) are scheduled to attend.

Ivy Tech, which has campuses throughout Indiana, is the state's largest public postsecondary institution and the nation's largest singly accredited statewide community college.

The Ivy Tech Community College campus in Noblesville, which cost \$30 million, including purchase of property and renovation, has evolved in its first year with the addition of the Excel Center, popular new educational programs and more inviting student space.

When the campus opened in Noblesville on Aug. 25, 2014, and became Ivy Tech's 32nd location, no one knew exactly what to expect, said Noblesville's Dan Clark, the campus president. "This is the first time the

Councils gather to learn

CARMEL — In an historic move, more than a dozen city and town councilors from across Hamilton County gathered Saturday at the Market District in Carmel for a countywide City Council Summit — the first in nearly a decade.

Councilors from Fishers, Noblesville, Westfield, Cicero and Sheridan discussed active listening, conflict negotiation as well as opportunities and issues facing Hamilton County.

"Sharing of ideas, planned projects and vision can become opportunity for all," said Noblesville City Councilor and former mayor Mary Sue Rowland. "This gives everyone an opportunity to learn more about their neighboring communities and what is happening next door."

Hamilton County Leadership Academy Class of 2016 project team organized the summit. HCLA is a leadership development program that identifies and educates future leaders during a 10-month program. Each class member must complete a capstone project that addresses a critical issue and creates positive change in Hamilton County. This is HCLA's 25th anniversary.

"We kept hearing about the same 'hot button' topics from every corner of Hamilton County, but when we asked how often these cities get the chance to work together, the answer was rarely," Blake Holler, a member of the 2016 HCLA class said.
